**SUBJECT: FLORIDA COURSE CODE DIRECTORY AND INSTRUCTIONAL PERSONNEL ASSIGNMENTS FOR 2006-2007**

State Board of Education Rule 6A-1.09441, FAC (Requirements for programs and courses which are funded through the Florida Education Finance Program and for which the student may earn credit toward high school graduation), provides specific conditions for which students may earn credit toward high school graduation and for which courses are funded through the Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP). The *Course Code Directory and Instructional Personnel Assignments* is incorporated by reference and made a part of this rule.

The *Course Code Directory and Instructional Personnel Assignments for 2006-2007* was approved by the State Board of Education in October 2005 as incorporated by reference into Rule 6A-1.09441, FAC, effective November 21, 2005. The State Board also approved the course descriptions for the new courses including essential content and course requirements in grades 6-12 in the Course Code Directory as amended in Rule 6A-1.09412, FAC (Course Requirements – Grades 6-12 Basic and Adult Secondary Programs).
