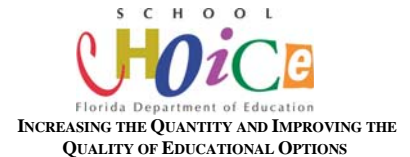

**SUBJECT:** **Technical Assistance Paper, Charter School Statute – HB 7103**
