**SUBJECT: TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PAPER REGARDING SUPPLEMENTAL EDUCATIONAL SERVICES (SES) IN TITLE I SCHOOLS – 2006 LEGISLATION**

Please find attached the Technical Assistance Paper (TAP) Regarding Supplemental Educational Services (SES) in Title I Schools. The purpose of this TAP is to provide technical assistance and guidance related to the new state law.

The 2006 Legislature passed Committee Substitute for Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 772 (CS/CS/SB 772) to create Section 1008.331, Florida Statutes (Supplemental Educational Services in Title I schools; school district and provider responsibilities), related to supplemental educational services (SES) for Title I schools identified as not making adequate yearly progress (AYP) for three or more consecutive years. The intent of the new law is to provide policy related to the responsibilities of school districts and providers relative to SES as required in Section 1116 of the No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act.
