## Driver License/School Attendance Program Report, First Quarter 2006-2007

**Summary:** Attached is a copy of data compiled from the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (DHSMV) for the first quarter of 2006-2007. This report now includes manual additions and deletions by department personnel. The names of students transmitted to the DHSMV will be mailed under separate cover to your district's Director of Student Services. This information reflects transactions processed for school districts from July 1, 2006, through September 30, 2006.

For the first quarter of the school year 2006-2007:

- 1,049 students received Notices of Intent to Suspend Driving Privileges
- 3,948 Notices of Intent to Suspend Driving Privileges were deleted
- 3,046 Non-Licensed drivers received notices that they were not eligible to apply and receive driver licenses
- 9,749 Non-Licensed/Non-Compliance Orders were deleted
- 623 Suspension Orders were issued
- 2,677 Suspension Orders were cleared or deleted
- 19 students who reinstated their driving privilege received 2<sup>nd</sup> suspension
