## Driver License/School Attendance Program Report, Second Quarter 2007-2008

**Summary:** Attached is a copy of data compiled from the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (DHSMV) for the second quarter of 2007-2008. This report now includes manual additions and deletions by department personnel. The names of students transmitted to the DHSMV will be mailed under separate cover to your district's Director of Student Services. This information reflects transactions processed for school districts from October 1, 2007, through December 31, 2007.

For the second quarter of the school year 2007-2008:

- 2,951 students received Notices of Intent to Suspend Driving Privileges
- 2,912 Notices of Intent to Suspend Driving Privileges were deleted
- 9,065 Non-Licensed drivers received notices that they were not eligible to apply and receive driver licenses
- 6,285 Non-Licensed/Non-Compliance Orders were deleted
- 2,466 Suspension Orders were issued
- 2,415 Suspension Orders were cleared or deleted
- 98 students who reinstated their driving privilege received 2nd suspension
