DRIVER LICENSE/SCHOOL ATTENDANCE PROGRAM REPORT

2008-2009 Second Quarter Report

Summary: Attached is a copy of data compiled from the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (DHSMV) for the second quarter of 2008-2009. This report now includes manual additions and deletions by department personnel. The names of students transmitted to the DHSMV will be mailed under separate cover to your district's Director of Student Services. This information reflects transactions processed for school districts from October 1, 2008 – December 31, 2008.

For the second quarter of the school year 2008-2009:

- 2,110 students received Notices of Intent to Suspend Driving Privileges
- 3,126 Notices of Intent to Suspend Driving Privileges were deleted
- 6,866 Non-Licensed drivers received notices that they were not eligible to apply and receive driver licenses
- 9,956 Non-Licensed/Non-Compliance Orders were deleted
- 1,645 Suspension Orders were issued
- 1,957 Suspension Orders were cleared or deleted
- 95 students who reinstated their driving privilege received 2nd suspension
