The Department of Education anticipates that federal funds will be available to public schools and school districts for K-12 service-learning projects for 2010-2011. Funding comes from the Corporation for National and Community Service and should be available for project awards effective August 1, 2010, for 12 months, contingent upon the timely release of federal funds to Florida.

The Department is releasing this application package to allow adequate planning and development by districts and schools. The complete application packet may be found at <http://learnandserve.hhp.ufl.edu>. We anticipate awards will be announced in the summer after funds have been received by the state. At least \$253,000 will be available for Renewal Projects (one-year awards to previously funded applicants, with an option to reapply). Applicant schools may apply for up to \$10,000, Florida Service-Learning Leader Schools may apply for up to \$15,000, and school districts may apply for up to \$50,000.

THE DEADLINE FOR RECEIPT OF APPLICATIONS IS MAY 21, 2010.

The goal of Florida Learn & Serve is to engage K-12 students in service-learning to improve academic performance, provide opportunities for civic engagement and career exploration, and address key needs in Florida communities. Service-learning provides students opportunities for school and/or community service activities that apply academic curricula and the Next Generation Sunshine State Standards.
