We strongly encourage each district to nominate administrators for these awards. The suggestions below may assist you in identifying and selecting deserving candidates for these awards.

- Distribute the nominate packets to leadership teams.
- Open the nomination process to other sources, i.e. colleagues, self, parents, community organizations, and student government groups.
- Appoint a special district-nominating committee to choose nominees or choose a slate of candidates from which the nominees are to be chosen at the district level.
- Select peer groups to nominate administrators, possibly during a regularly-scheduled administrators' meeting.
- Utilize area Superintendents to choose nominees or nominate candidates from which a district-level committee chooses the final recipients.
- Nominate a school leader whose students have made remarkable achievements under unique or otherwise extraordinary circumstances.
