## MEMORANDUM

**SUBJECT: Posting District Evaluation Systems on District Public Websites**

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The content of district evaluation systems is a primary method of focusing Florida's educators on performance expectations and priorities. Each district's evaluation system for instructional personnel and school administrators plays a significant role in informing district employees and stakeholders in public education about how we hold ourselves accountable.

Once approved by the Department of Education (Department), a district's evaluation system documentation for instructional personnel and school administrators must be posted on the school district's publicly accessible website. Full approval for instructional personnel evaluation systems has been provided to 33 districts. Each district which has received full approval should notify the Department by January 6, 2012, of the district's website location (URL) where the evaluation documentation has been posted. Each district's web link will be posted to the Department's website for District Performance Evaluation Systems (<http://www.fldoe.org/profdev/pa.asp>).

Those districts which are awaiting full approval should post their documentation within two weeks of receipt of full approval.
