SUBJECT: 2002-2003 Weekends with the Experts for Speech/Language Pathologists

The Florida Department of Education, Bureau of Instructional Support and Community Services, is pleased to announce the 30th Annual Speech/Language Weekends with the Experts. The workshops provide Speech/Language pathologists working in public schools an opportunity for continuing education by bringing experts from around the country to Florida. Enclosed is a flier announcing the Speech/Language Weekends with the Experts program, co-sponsored by the Bureau of Instructional Support and Community Services and the Florida Comprehensive System of Personnel Development Project.
