SUBJECT: Save the Date – 2013 Common Core State Standards Summer Institutes

The Florida Department of Education is pleased to present the 2013 Common Core State Standards (CCSS) Summer Institutes and invites faculty, staff, and leadership responsible for teacher preparation and other postsecondary programs in Florida’s higher education institutions to save the dates. Participants will gain an increased knowledge of the CCSS and shifts in instruction to enhance learning opportunities and instructional delivery to support student success. More specifically, participants will 1) be prepared to integrate and implement the CCSS in all content areas, 2) understand how standards-based instruction supports teacher effectiveness, and 3) leave with model lessons, instructional tools, and additional resources to support implementation of CCSS. This year there will be seven two-day institutes held at high schools around the state.
