Governor Rick Scott signed Senate Bill 1076, Relating to K-20 Education, into law with an effective date of July 1, 2013. Its provisions address numerous areas, including Academically Challenging Curriculum to Enhance Learning (ACCEL) options, middle grades progression, high school graduation requirements, student assessment and student progression plans.

This memorandum provides frequently asked questions and answers to assist districts with the implementation of the changes made by this legislation. In the coming months, the Florida Department of Education will continue to provide technical assistance and resources for implementing these provisions.
