As part of Race to the Top (RTTT) Assurance Area C (Data Systems to Support Instruction) and per Section 1006.281, Florida Statutes, school districts are required to implement the minimum standards for a Local Instructional Improvement System (LIIS) by June 30, 2014. The LIIS minimum standards are published online at <http://www.fldoe.org/arra/LIISMS.asp>.

In September 2011 and September 2012, the Florida Department of Education requested school districts (both RTTT and non-RTTT) to complete a survey reporting on their efforts to establish an LIIS that meets these standards. The FDOE has completed an analysis of the baseline survey results (from 2011) and the fall 2012 survey results and has developed reports for both state-level aggregate data and individual district-level data. The state-level aggregate reports are online at <http://www.fldoe.org/arra/LIISMS.asp>.

For the fall 2013 LIIS survey, the narrative report and technology survey will be available for districts to complete between August 15 and September 30, 2013. Login instructions will be provided separately to your LIIS project lead. We strongly encourage districts to collaborate between their assessment, curriculum and technology departments to review the needs and status of their LIIS.
