**SUBJECT:** Title I Fund Allocation for Eligible Non-Public School Children

The No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLB), Section 1120 (a)(4) requires that, "Expenditures for educational services and other benefits to eligible private school children shall be equal to the proportion of funds allocated to participating school attendance areas based on the number of children from low-income families who attend private schools." The State often receives requests for pertinent information on this subject from Federal, not-for-profit, and private agencies.
