SUBJECT: Application Posted for the Private School Opportunity to Administer Florida Statewide Assessments in 2018–19

Beginning with the 2013–14 school year, any private school with at least one enrolled Florida Tax Credit (FTC) Scholarship student was eligible to apply to the Florida Department of Education to administer Florida statewide assessments (e.g., FSA assessments, Florida End-of-Course [EOC] Assessments, Statewide Science Assessment) to all students at the private school, per section 1002.395, Florida Statutes (F.S.). Beginning with the 2015–16 school year, private schools with at least one enrolled Gardiner Scholarship student are also eligible to apply, per s. 1002.385, F.S. The purpose of this memorandum is to announce that the application for private schools to administer Florida statewide assessments in 2018–19 is now available. The application window for participation in the 2018–19 assessment administrations is January 1–March 1, 2018. The Office of Independent Education and Parental Choice will inform private schools with eligible students of this opportunity. You are not responsible for contacting private schools, but we do ask for your cooperation with any private schools that contact the district to inquire about testing policies, requirements and training. If a private school in your district is approved to administer Florida statewide assessments in 2018–19, you will be notified by the department. The private school will be responsible for contacting your district assessment office to provide school assessment coordinator contact information and any other details required by the district to include the private school in the state assessment program.
