**SUBJECT: Turnaround School Supplemental Services Allocation (TSSSA)**

The 2019 Florida Legislature passed [Senate Bill 7070](#), K-12 Education, and Governor Ron DeSantis signed the bill on May 9, 2019. It includes a new Turnaround School Supplemental Services Allocation (TSSSA). Eligibility will be based on 2019 school grades and meeting one of the following three criteria: a school implementing a district-managed turnaround plan, a school that has earned at least three consecutive grades below a “C,” or a school that has improved to a “C” or higher and is no longer in turnaround status within the last two years.

These funds include a per-FTE funding amount of \$500. Districts are required to complete a TSSSA plan which will be accessible at <http://www.floridacims.org>. Districts may begin planning for this allocation based on projections of the FEFP Conference Report dated May 1, 2019. Once the preliminary 2019 school grade list is released, the updated allocation list will be posted. The supplement will be recalculated during the October FTE survey.

The TSSSA plan must be submitted to your school board for approval by **August 1, 2019**. An approved plan is due to the Bureau of School Improvement (BSI) no later than **September 1, 2019**.

BSI will host a technical assistance webinar regarding TSSSA to help answer any questions.
