Pursuant to section 1002.333, Florida Statutes, as amended by Senate Bill 7070 in the 2019 legislative session, Persistently Low-Performing Schools are identified as schools that earned three grades lower than a “C” in at least three of the previous five school years and have not earned a grade of “B” or higher in the most recent two school years. The attached list identifies those traditional public schools that earned either a “D” or “F” in three of the previous five school years (2018-19, 2017-18, 2016-17, 2015-16, and/or 2014-15) and did not earn a grade of “A” or “B” in both of the most recent two school years (2018-19 and 2017-18).

Please note that the 30-day appeals period is currently open for the 2018-19 school grades; therefore, this list is preliminary. School grades for some schools may change, and as a result, this list may change based on appeals. Please review the memorandum outlining the process for appealing school grades, which was sent on July 15, 2019. As a reminder, the deadline to submit an appeal is **Wednesday, August 14, 2019**.
