Florida Statutes provides for the requirement of proper documentation prior to school entry and attendance immunization (HRS 680-A) is issued when 5+ doses of DTaP, 4+ doses of polio, and 2 doses of measles, 1 mumps (or 2 MMR), 3 hepatitis B and 1 varicella (or 4 DTaP, 3 polio, 2 measles, 1 mumps, and 1 rubella, 3 hepatitis B and 1 varicella) are administered. If the last dose of DTaP and polio were given on or after child's fourth birthday are administered
