**MEMORANDUM**

**SUBJECT: List of Providers for School District Virtual Instruction Programs**

Section 1002.45, Florida Statutes, establishes Virtual Instruction Programs (VIP) and requires all school districts to provide a VIP to eligible students. To provide this option for their students, districts may:

- Contract with Florida Virtual School;
- Establish a franchise of Florida Virtual School;
- Contract with an approved VIP provider; or
- Enter into an agreement with another district or virtual charter school.

Subsection (2) of the statute requires the department to annually publish a list of providers approved to offer virtual instruction programs. Providers seeking to appear on the list must submit an electronic application to the department. The application review for VIP providers seeking approval for the 2022-23 school year has been completed. The following providers are included on the list:

- Accel Online East (Grades K-12) New
- Connections Education of Florida, LLC (Grades K-12) Renewed
- Edgenuity Inc. (Grades K-12) Renewed
- K12 Florida, LLC (Grades K-12) Renewed
- Optima Domi (Grades K-8) New
