Driver License/School Attendance Program Report, Second Quarter 2006-2007

Summary: Attached is a copy of data compiled from the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (DHSMV) for the second quarter of 2006-2007. This report now includes manual additions and deletions by Department personnel. The names of students transmitted to the DHSMV will be mailed under separate cover to your district's Director of Student Services. This information reflects transactions processed for school districts from October 1, 2006, through December 31, 2006.

For the second quarter of the school year 2006-2007:

- 3,466 students received Notices of Intent to Suspend Driving Privileges
- 3,099 Notices of Intent to Suspend Driving Privileges were deleted
- 11,375 Non-Licensed drivers received notices that they were not eligible to apply and receive driver licenses
- 7,204 Non-Licensed/Non-Compliance Orders were deleted
- 3,086 Suspension Orders were issued
- 2,461 Suspension Orders were cleared or deleted
- 160 students who reinstated their driving privilege received 2nd suspension
