SUBJECT: Postsecondary Preparatory Instructional Placement for 2012-2013

The following information is provided to guide instructional placement for students who have not demonstrated college readiness as described under section 1008.22(3)(c), F.S. The five courses referenced below are academic/core credit courses, and as such all must satisfy the class size requirements. Given the alignment of course content to the Postsecondary Readiness Competencies, the rigor of the “Success” courses has increased; therefore, these courses may now be awarded academic/core credit for graduation.

English 4: College Prep (1001405 – 1 credit)
Reading for College Success (1008350 – 0.5 credit)
Writing for College Success (1009370 – 0.5 credit)

Mathematics for College Readiness (1200700 – 1 credit)
Mathematics for College Success (1200410 – 0.5 credit)

Attached you will find copies of the revised course descriptions for 2012-2013. As previously stated, these courses are aligned to the Postsecondary Readiness Competencies; they are also fully aligned to the Common Core State Standards for English Language Arts and Mathematics.
