In the Fall of 2004 and Spring of 2005, the Center for Educational Research and Policy Studies plans to offer courses that meet competency 3 and 4/5.

Course Tuition & Books

Applicants accepted into the reading program will receive a waiver of FSU graduate tuition for each course they are enrolled in and attend. All course books and manuals will be provided at no charge.

Stipend Benefit

Students will receive a stipend of \$150 per course to offset travel/daycare expenses or other incidental expenses. Once grades are posted on August 17th, stipends will be processed for students with a grade of "C" or higher and who have no outstanding accounts payable to FSU. Processing of the stipend check may take at least 30 days.

Grades

In order to document course completion for certification or for any other reason, students will need to request an official transcript. Grades will be posted to transcripts on August 17th.

Course Registration Information

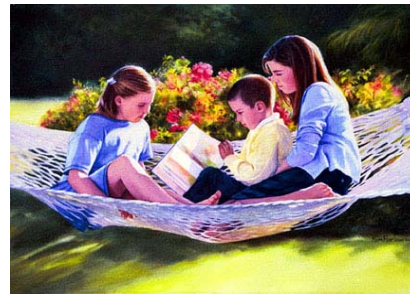
Registration is on a first-come, first-serve basis and is limited to Florida public school teachers of reading. Priority will be given to 6-12th grade reading teachers through an early registration period.

Summer priority registration: April 1st - April 30th.

School personnel involved in teaching reading as a reading coach, counselor, department head, principal or administrator of a reading curriculum will also be given priority status. Other teachers involved in reading activities are encouraged to register and will be placed on a wait list and accepted on a space-available basis.

Individual classes are capped at 25 students per class per site. Course sections will be filled with waiting list applicants once priority registration dates are closed. At this time, if additional spaces are available, waiting list applicants will be accepted up to the first week of classes.

University admissions and registration are processed through the Florida State University Center for Professional Development (FSU/CPD) or the FSU Panama City Registrar. To be admitted to FSU and to be registered for one or more classes, you will be required to furnish a complete 2004 Reading Program Application Package. A checklist form will be provided to guide you through this process. If your application arrives incomplete, it will be returned to you and no space will be held. If your completed application arrives after the class capacity of 25 students is reached for the class(es) you have selected, you will be placed on a waiting list and notified.
