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
This report, covering the 1999/2000 school year, contains data on PK-12 students in Title I programs in the State of Florida. All data is from the Florida Department of Education Student Data Base. Data is disaggregated by Title I program type and/or Free or Reduced Price Lunch status. Please note that, because of methods used to group students, and the number and type of schools included, this report, while internally consistent, may differ from others issued by the Department. For details on these differences, please contact the Bureau of Equity, Safety, and School Support.

Title I Schoolwide programs are those in which, given 50% or more of students eligible for Free or Reduced Price Lunch, the school administration has opted to serve all students in the school under Title I; Targeted Assistance Programs are those which either do not meet the Schoolwide Criteria, or the school has chosen this option, and only those students who are Eligible for Free or Reduced Price Lunch are served under Title I; Non-Title I appears here for comparative purposes.



The National School Lunch Program is a program of the U. S. Department of Agriculture. Eligibility is determined by the income level of the family using the Federal poverty guidelines set by the U. S. Department of Health and Human Services. Under these guidelines a family of four with an income below \$16,700 is considered in poverty. Eligibility for Reduced Price Lunch is based on 185% of the poverty level (\$30,895 family of four), Free Lunch on 130% (\$21,710 family of four). In Fiscal Year 1999 the National School Lunch Program served 220,122,579 lunches in Florida and Florida schools received \$297,573,502.
