We would like to take this opportunity to clarify the requirements for the Baseline and Mid-Year Data Reports that are required for schools in Differentiated Accountability (DA) for the 2010-2011 school year.

All DA schools should submit Baseline Data, Mid-Year Data, and a Mid-Year Narrative Report. Non-Title I and Title I “A”, “B”, and “C” DA schools are only required to submit Baseline and Mid-Year Data and a Mid-Year Narrative Report for subgroups who did not make Adequate Yearly Progress during the prior school year. Interim assessments used for reading, mathematics, and science are at the discretion of the district and should be aligned to the Next Generation of Sunshine State Standards and predictive of Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test performance. Provided below are tables that outline the requirements for each subject by grade level.
